VIGNETO CA' DI MARTE



It is a small vineyard of 0.8 hectares that we have been renting since 2018 and, with its 900 metres distance as the crow flies from La Tosa, it is our furthest vineyard (so to speak) from the winery. It was planted in 2002, with Barbera and Bonarda vines trained by Guyot.

The altitude is 175-180 metres, the exposure is north-south with good sunshine, and the vineyard is mostly level, except for the extreme north-eastern part, which is slightly sloping.

The soil is clayey-loamy with a particular red vein in the sloping part. In the latter part, the soil is very poorly fertile, which means that the bunches are very small and concentrated and the grape yield is low, and there is a certain presence of small stones. In the rest of the vineyard, on the other hand, the soil is more fertile, which is also reflected in the more widespread spontaneous grass cover, and gives the grapes good nutrients and good flavour balance.



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
